Delivery Driver / Shop & Warehouse Assistant

Reports to: Warehouse Manager

Purpose: Delivers customer orders on a daily route within the greater Spokane area. Responsible for stocking inventory and fabrication of hydraulic and industrial hoses and their associated hardware in our fabrication shop.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Performs the following delivery duties as backup to primary Delivery Driver:
 - Drives delivery van to customer's place of business to deliver materials and supplies ordered. Estimated days per week driving: two.
 - Greets customers in a friendly, courteous and professional manner.
 - Answers questions regarding materials and supplies ordered.
 - Listens to and resolves any service complaints.
 - Picks up shop supplies as directed to return to store.
 - Daily bank deposits and change orders as directed.
 - Provides routine cleaning and fueling on delivery van.
 - Provides routine maintenance as directed on delivery van.
- Performs the following fabrication procedures under the supervision of the Shop Foreman:
 - Cutting hose to customer specification.
 - Attaching components to manufacturer specification & NAHAD guidelines.
 - Hydrostatically pressure test hose for leak detection, if required.
- Performs the following warehousing procedures:
 - Maintains and replenishes stock areas in warehouse as needed
 - Maintains clean and safe work environment by keeping shelves, pallet areas, and workstations neat.
- Customer order entry and fulfillment procedures:
 - Prepares sales orders.
 - Checks inventory and pulls for order fulfillment, noting any stock changes on pick tickets for proper billing and backorder procedures.
- Other
 - Detects and reports equipment, defective material, improper operations, and unusual conditions to appropriate level of management.
 - Works in manner that ensures the safety of all oneself and others.
 - Exercises proper care in the use of tools and equipment.

- Maintains quality customer service by following organizational standards.
- Attends manufacturer and safety training programs as well as in-house workshops as directed.
