Purpose: Responsible for stocking inventory and fabrication of hydraulic and industrial hoses and their associated hardware in our fabrication shop.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Performs the following fabrication procedures under the supervision of the Shop Foreman:
 - Cutting hose to customer specification.
 - Attaching components to manufacturer specification & NAHAD guidelines.
 - Hydrostatically pressure test hose for leak detection, if required.
- Performs the following receiving and warehousing procedures:
 - Receives and verifies incoming parts, materials and supplies.
 - \circ $\,$ Maintains and replenishes stock areas in warehouse as needed
 - Maintains clean and safe work environment by keeping shelves, pallet areas, and work stations neat.
- Customer order entry and fulfillment procedures:
 - Prepare sales orders.
 - Check inventory and pulls for order fulfillment; noting any stock changes on pick tickets for proper billing and backorder procedures.
- Other
 - Detects and reports equipment, defective material, improper operations, and unusual conditions to appropriate level of management.
 - Works in manner that ensures the safety of all oneself and others.
 - Exercises proper care in the use of tools and equipment.
 - Maintains quality customer service by following organizational standards.
 - Attends manufacturer and safety training programs as well as in-house workshops as directed.
